PSC A/S offers the following information relative to EU Directives 2003/11/EU, 2006/122/EC, **2011/65/EU (RoHS)** and the 2015/863/EU amendment for the following materials:

**All parts supplied.**

**Directive 2003/11/EC (Penta- and OctaBDE)**

On February 15, 2003 the European Union (EU) published the 24th amendment to the Parliament and Council

Directive 76/769/EEC with directive 2003/11/EC relating to restrictions on the marketing and use of certain substances and preparations containing the brominated fire retardants Pentabromodiphenyl ether (PentaBDE) and Octabromodiphenyl ether (OctaBDE). This ban became effective August 15, 2004.

**PSC A/S does not produce or ship any products with amounts of PentaBDE or OctaBDE.**

**PSC A/S is in full compliance with this directive.**

For DecaBDE – see **Directive 2011/65/EC (RoHS statement)**

**Directive 2006/122/EC (Perfluorooctane Sulfonates - PFOS)**

On December 12, 2006 the European Union (EU) published the 30th amendment to the Parliament and Council

**Directive 76/769/EEC with directive 2006/122/EC** on the approximation of the laws, regulations and administrative provisions of the Member States relating to restrictions on the marketing and use of certain dangerous substances and preparations (Perfluorooctane sulfonates - PFOS).

**PSC A/S does not produce or ship any products with amounts of PFOS.**

**PSC A/S is in full compliance with this directive.**

**Directive 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU - Reduction of Hazardous Substance (RoHS)**

This EU directive requires the reduction of hazardous materials linked to specified heavy metals and flame retardants.


This directive specifies that new electrical and electronic equipment will not contain Lead (Pb), Mercury (Hg), Cadmium (Cd), Hexavalent Chromium (Cr-VI), Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB) or Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE) with the exception of those items listed as exempted in the annex to Directive 2011/65/EC.

Also included are cat. 8 & 9 substances (DBP, DEHP, BPP and DIBP) in effect by July 2021 (2015/863/EU).

Finally, the POP Regulation (Regulation (EU) 2019/1021), is covered by this compliance statement.
